

Last Tuesday night there was a wonderful program on the ABC it was called "Flyways: The Story of Migratory Shorebirds". The Eastern Curlew flies from Moreton Bay in Queensland to Russia or north-eastern China to breed. It is a threatened species and scientists are trying to track where the birds fly and whether they can find feeding grounds along the way and breeding grounds when they arrive. They fly 9,000 to 12,000 kms each way.

The stamina of these and other birds that fly great distances to their breeding grounds is amazing. It just goes to show more of God's incredible creation.

Another story I've read is about Eagles.

Did you know that an eagle knows when a storm is approaching long before it breaks? The eagle will fly to some high spot and wait for the winds to come. When the storm hits, it sets its wings so that the wind will pick it up and lift it above the storm. While the storm rages below, the eagle is soaring above it.

The eagle does not escape the storm. It simply uses the storm to lift it higher. It rises on the winds that bring the storm.

When the storms of life come upon us - and all of us will experience them - we can rise above them by setting our minds and our belief toward God. The storms do not have to overcome us. We can allow God's power to lift us above them.

God enables us to ride the winds of the storm that bring sickness, tragedy, failure and disappointment in our lives. We can soar above the storm.
